Code of Conduct – Hallett Cove Officials and Volunteers

The following code of conduct gives guidance to the Officials and Volunteers who are responsible for providing the services at Hallett Cove Netball Club.

1. Treat everyone with respect and honesty. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in netball regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, or religion.
2. Always maintain a duty of care towards others.
3. Establish and maintain a Child Safe Environment for children and young people.
4. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18.
5. Follow all Hallett Cove Netball Club and SAUCNA policies and guidelines.
6. Raise any concerns, problems, or issues with the committee as soon as possible.
7. Verbal or physical abuse of umpires, coaches, players, parents and spectators and any other officials will not be tolerated.

Unacceptable behaviour by any Club Official or Volunteer is taken seriously by Hallett Cove Netball club and by SAUCNA. Approaches are not to be made directly to the President or Secretary of Hallett Cove Netball Club as soon as possible following the match in question. Hallett Cove Netball Club will take up the matter with the relevant parties following the complaints process laid down by the Association.
