Code of Conduct – Players

1. Play by the rules.
2. **Never** argue with the umpire's decision.
3. Players are only permitted to approach the umpires during intervals to seek clarification of rules.
4. Respect and co-operate with your coach, teammates, opponents, and officials at all times.
5. Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
6. Work equally hard for yourself and your team, do your personal best and encourage your teammates to do the same.
7. Control your temper. Verbal or physical abuse of officials or other players, deliberately contacting or provoking an opponent, and the misuse of equipment is not acceptable or permitted.
8. At all times, conduct yourself in a manner expected by your club and act in a fair and sporting manner, both on and off the court. Wear your uniform with pride.
9. Follow all Hallett Cove Netball Club and SAUCNA policies and guidelines.
10. Contribute to our club spirit by recognising, welcoming, and supporting all members of our club.
11. At the end of every match, thank and acknowledge the opposing team and umpires, irrespective of the outcome.

Unacceptable behaviour by any player is taken seriously by Hallett Cove Netball Club and by SAUCNA. Approaches are not to be made directly to anyone suspected of unacceptable behaviour but are to be directed to the President or Secretary of Hallett Cove Netball Club as soon as possible following the match in question. Hallett Cove Netball Club will take up the matter with the relevant parties following the complaints process laid down by the Association.
